- excellent cleaning of the ink rollers

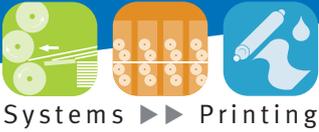
Features

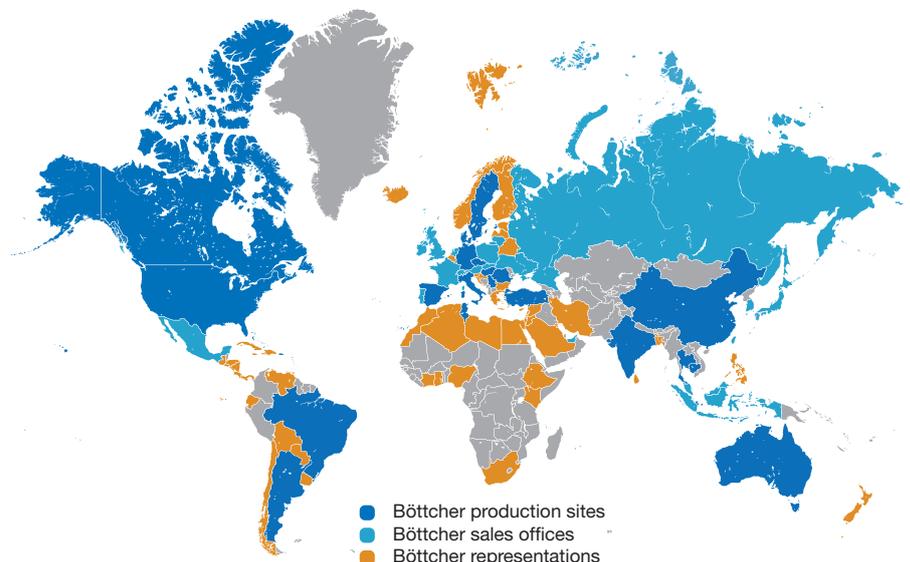
